## Customs and Border Patrol

The Importer Security Filing (ISF), also known as 10+2, is a U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) regulation requiring importers and vessel carriers to provide data electronically to CBP for in-bound ocean shipments. ISF improves CBP's ability to recognize high-risk shipments in advance to ensure the safety of America's borders.

## Food and Drug Administration

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) requires companies to file a Prior Notice for any food shipment imported into the United States. Prior Notice must be received and confirmed no more than five days before arrival and no less than two hours if arriving by road, four hours if arriving by air or rail, or eight hours if arriving by water.

## Penalties for Incorrect Filing

ISF forms that are improperly filed may result in fines or penalties from CBP. The shipment could also be detained by Customs and Border Control, and secured through a customs bond.

Failure to provide the FDA a Prior Notice in a timely manner will result in the food or beverage being denied entry until errors are corrected. Companies could also be fined by the FDA for failing to provide Prior Notice.

Filing a Prior Notice with U.S. FDA is required for all food and beverage shipments entering the United States, including samples. Registrar Corp's Prior Notice Express allows you to quickly file your Prior Notice via Fax or Online.
